

Greetings Scott's All*Stars supporters,

It is with great pleasure I bring to you Scott's All*Stars. Scott's All*Stars program is an Academic/Basketball Program for students who have the potential to attend college and play basketball at the college level. Students must have an 80 GPA, no discipline problems, and perform community service activities. We teach life skills that will prepare them to be successful students and productive citizens. Our mission is "to teach basketball and life skills to a group of young boys in 4th grade that have the potential academically and athletically to play basketball on the college level". Our vision is to remain with our team members until they graduate from high school by placing them in a mentoring program that will continue to motivate them to reach their athletic, academic and community goals.

We are very proud of our team's progress this year and the community support. Without supportive parents and community supporters this program would not be as successful. Scott's All*Stars theme for this banquet is "All*Stars at All*Cost." This is a fitting theme because in order to be an "All*Star" there is a heavy cost in time, effort, and commitment. Our team participants must perform community service activities once a month, maintain a "B" average, and stay out of trouble. Parents are also required to assist with multiple fundraiser activities, make sure there child is committed to the program, and transport their child to practice at least every weekend. Being an All*Stars is easier said than done! Scott's All*Stars is committed to helping children academically and athletically, but it requires more efforts from the players and parents. Our parents and players commit to this program for six months and once they become an "All*Stars", they are always an "All*Stars". During the off season we continue to mentor our kids with bi-monthly community service and mentoring activities.

When I started this program in January of this year, I stated that it would be the "Premier Program" in Georgia. Now that the program has become a success we look forward to having more participants next year who will benefit from the program. It is our vision that all players will attend college on an academic and/or athletic scholarship. We look forward to continuing working with our future NBA athletes, but most importantly we look forward to continuing to work with our scholarly minded college graduates, who will be able to choose any career they desire. THURBERT E. BAKER

Thurbert E. Baker has served as Georgia's Attorney General since 1997. He has won three statewide elections for Attorney General, and in his most recent election, he carried 122 of Georgia's 159 counties.

As Attorney General, Mr. Baker has focused on fighting crime, corruption and consumer fraud. He wrote both Georgia's groundbreaking mortgage fraud statute as well as Georgia's financial identity fraud statute, allowing law enforcement to break up and imprison fraud rings operating in Georgia. Mr. Baker has fought to protect Georgia's children by proposing and successfully passing legislation that increased penalties for child pornographers and closed loopholes in Georgia's child pornography laws. Attorney General Baker has also been a strong advocate for Georgia's Open Government laws, creating a mediation program in the Office of Attorney General dedicated to working with citizens and local governments to ensure that records and meetings covered by Georgia's Open

Government laws are open to the public as well as successfully litigating against organizations which refused to turn over documents covered by the Open Records Act.

Prior to his service as Attorney General, Mr. Baker served five terms in the Georgia House of Representatives, including three terms as Floor Leader for then-Governor Zell Miller. During his time in the legislature, he authored legislation that created the HOPE scholarship program and enacted Georgia's "Two Strikes and You're Out" law that puts the worst repeat violent offenders in prison for life without parole.

Attorney General Baker received his undergraduate degree from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, and his law degree from Emory University School of Law. While at Chapel Hill, Mr. Baker was a member of the fencing team and the 1975 Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) individual sabre champion. In 2002, the ACC recognized Mr. Baker as one of the top fencers in conference history.

Attorney General Baker has taken an active role in the National Association of Attorneys General, where he has been elected by his colleagues to serve as National President during the 2006-2007 term. In the community, Attorney General Baker serves as a trustee for his church, Ebenezer Baptist Church, as well as on Emory University's Board of Visitors. Attorney General Baker lives in Stone Mountain with his wife, Catherine. They have two daughters, Jocelyn and Chelsea.



MAYOR JAMES (JIM) THOMAS, JR., City of Hinesville

James (Jim) Thomas, Jr. is a retired military officer and a 30 year resident of Liberty County. He retired from DOD civil service in March of 2006. He is currently running his consulting firm. He has been active in the local community for over 26 years. He was elected Mayor of Hinesville in November 2007. He is also a member of the Liberty County Hospital Authority, Hinesville Metropolitan Planning Organization, Hinesville Architectural Review Board, Hinesville Military Affairs Committee, NAACP, MENSA, INTERTEL, 11 Black Men of Liberty County and several other local civic organizations. Jim attends Mt. Zion Missionary Baptist Church in Hinesville.

Jim obtained his BA in Business Management and Administration from Saint Leo University. He has completed graduate studies in Business Management from Central Michigan University and Public Administration

from Georgia Southern University. He is a trained and experienced Engineering Project Manager.

As a former DOD civil service employee, he has served as a liaison between Fort Stewart, Liberty County and the city of Hinesville. He was the Project Manager for the Joint Use Airport Committee and Project Manager for the construction for "Warriors Walk" (a memorial to our fallen soldiers and civilians at Fort Stewart).



HISTORY

The Scott's All*Stars Program started on January 15th 2010 with our first tryouts conducted by the president Marcus Scott, IV; head coach Daryl West and assistant coaches Khari Collins and Kevin Corwick. The vision for Scott's All*Stars began when Marcus Scott, IV noticed there was no basketball programs designed for children his son's age in the Hinesville area. While many thought starting a 10 and under AAU basketball program was a great idea, no one wanted to commit the time and effort needed to start one. Marcus Scott, IV was determined that his son, Marcus Scott, V, would not have to wait until he got to high school to face the level on competition that kids his age faced in the North Georgia area. Therefore, Marcus Scott started doing research so he could discover the best way to implement his program. First and Foremost, he knew he needed a coach and a gym. The YMCA volunteered to allow the organization to use their gym and Daryl West his longtime friend agreed to be the Head Coach.

Although AAU is a great basketball program Mr. Scott realized it lacked one great quality which was an academic component. By not striving for academic excellence along with athletics the players would have a false sense of what was necessary to reach success in life. This is why Mr. Scott not only requires the players to have a passing grade, but also to maintain an 80 average. Scott's All*Stars teaches their players that average is below average and excellence is what is expected. Mr. Scott also wanted the players to always feel a need to give back to the community, which is why he added a community service element to his program. Mr. Scott and his staff members are committed to working with his players until they graduate from high school and attend college. Mr. Scott goal is for all his players to receive a college scholarship for basketball, academics or both! Scott's All*Stars is committed to making sure all the original players that stay in the program until they graduate from high school receive a full college scholarship.

Scott All*Stars competed in many tournaments this year. In only our first year we are now a Premier Academic/Basketball Program in Georgia. Scott's All*Stars is not a basketball program, but an academic program that incorporates basketball and academic excellence. All players understand that academic is and always will be more important than athletics.

Head Coach Daryl West, lead Scott's All*Stars to a 12-5 record which allowed our team to qualify for Division I, II and III national championship. We also won the Super-Regional Tournament in Charleston, South Carolina. This is a phenomenal achievement due to the fact that most programs do not win a game their first season.

Furthermore, we have surpassed the required grade point average with a team GPA of 87. This is also a remarkable accomplishment, which follows our commitment to academic excellence instead of academic mediocrity.
